Monterey, CA, but there is a
problem since there is no So.
Main St., or Main St. in
Monterey or New Monterey. The
nearby town of Salinas, CA., is
another possibility, and it does
have a So. Main Street which is
also called Rt. 68 - the Salinas-
Monterey Highway that runs out
of Salinas to Monterey."

HA-4(29)2 - William H.
Harsha/Member of Congress
....1968-d cent, rd, **Plymouth,
Ohio, Lawniczak, Jim writes,
"This piece is attributed to
Plymouth, Ohio in the second
draft of the Ohio encased catalog.
An internet search of all
Congressmen, past and present
shows that Harsha was an Ohio
Congressmen from the 5th

district from 1961 until at least
1973 and resided during that
period in Portsmouth. Also
according to the Internet, there is
a William H. Harsha Lake in
Clermont County in South West
Ohio (3 counties west of
Portsmouth) and a William H.
Harsha is currently an appeals
court judge in Circleville, which
is about 60 miles north of
Portsmouth."

location of the cent relative to
inscription, reverse inscription,

location of hole(if present) and
size.

writes, "I recently decided to do
a blitz to determine where this
piece is from, and I tracked it
down to Salem (not Youngstown)

Ohio It's amazing what is on the internet—someone posted the itinerary of the 1957 Inspection Tour of Pennsylvania Railroad Board of Directors. One of the stops was Salem, Ohio where the Youngstown Kitchens Division of the American Radiator & Standard Sanitary Co. was then located. This led me to call the public library in Salem. The Mullins family is the leading family in Salem. The Mullins Manufacturing Corp. was founded by William H. Mullins, who died in 1932 at the age of 79. Youngstown Kitchens were a system of sink and cabinets made of metal with a porcelain top manufactured in Salem. Further work on the Internet showed that the Mullins Manufacturing Corp. was merged into the American Radiator & Standard Sanitary Co. in 1956, which company is still in existence today, with headquarters in New Jersey, with the name of American Standard, Inc. According to my source at the Salem library, the old Mullins property is no longer in use, but American Standard is still manufacturing their toilets in Salem today."

CH-2(280)9 - Charlie's for Liquors, 200 E. Whittier Blvd, ... 1945 cent, rd. *La Habra, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "address fits La Habra, CA. Needs further work, but very probable." Duane needs cent location for cataloging.

MA-3(295)9 - Maud's Flour/ GF 10c/On Purchase/of 24 lb sack.....1937 cent, rd.

**Davenport, IA, Feisel, Duane writes, "according to Glass & O'Connor in Iowa Trade Tokens."

AC-1(306)10 - ACME Jewelers, 926 S. Atlantic Blvd... Diamonds - Watches, 1946 rd.

**Los Angeles, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "Address fits LA, listing for Acme Jewelers in 1953 D&B." Cent location and additional information needed by Duane.

OS-2(339)10 - Osterman & Levy Kredit Jewelers, next to Tiedke's, 1945 cent, rd. **Toledo, Ohio, Lawniczak, Jim writes, "I tracked this down by talking to my mother. Osterman & Tiedke's were on Summit Street in Toledo, Ohio, on the west bank of the Maumee River. Today, this is the Portside shopping and entertainment area. Tiedke's was the large downtown department store in Toledo when I was growing up there in the 50's, with the Santa displays at Christmas. My grandmother worked there on and off for 50 years, in between 10 children. My mother's wedding ring was purchased from Osterman & Levy in 1948."

SE-4(341)10 - Servant Enterprises, Canoga Park...1970-d cent, hs. *Canoga Park, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "Unverified attribution, but there is no other Canoga Park in the U.S."

BU-6(350)11 - Burr's/For Nationally/Known Merchandise, 1945 cent, rd. **Paragould, Greene County, Arkansas, Hinkle, Walt writes, "Burr's is from Paragould, Green County, Arkansas, located at 101 South Pruett St. I went to Paragould in the 1960's and identified tokens and encased from there. My Burr's is unc. 1946."

TO-2(399)11 - Topolos Bros., Automotive Specialists, No.1, Franklin St., rd. **San Francisco, Ca., Feisel, Duane writes, "Attribution from another piece which is inscribed San Francisco." Duane needs

additional information for cataloging.

WH-3(460)12 - White Front Appl. Co./7651 S. Central... and **WH-1(25)1** **Los Angeles, CA., Feisel, Duane writes, Listed in 1953 D&B, address is 7657, typo in latter listing.

SC-3(539)14 - Re-Elect Paul f. Schenck to Congress, 1957-d cent, rd. **Dayton, OH, Lawniczak, Jim writes, "The internet's directory of Congressmen identified this piece. Paul Fornshell Schenck was a U.S. Congressmen from Dayton, Ohio, 1951-1965. He was a Republican and his streak ended in the Johnson landslide of 1964. He died in 1968."

AA-1(602)16 - A-A Liquors/Mac & Larry/6200 Manchester Ave.... 1948 cent, rd. **Los Angeles, CA. Feisel, Duane writes, "I have another piece cataloged from the same business. Street address is 6200 not 620."

BE-15(613)16 - A. Berkowitz/243 High St./Hamilton/1901 cent, cp. **Hamilton, OH, Feisel, Duane writes, "Cataloged by Lipscomp(also a goblet shape) There is a typo: maker name is GEO. H. JUNG & CO. Cin.O. There is an omission: on the reverse in small letters at the left side is: Pat. Apl'd For."

BY-1-Correction BR(629)16 - Bryres Inc./Furniture Appliances/116 E. 5th St./Oxnard 2274, 1947 cent, hs. **Oxnard, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "Typo in listing-Brynes, not Byres, Brynes, furniture and appliances, listed in 1953 D&B Fully listed in the CA encased catalog, piece is holed."

A+P-1(650)17 - A & P, Come See You'll Save at A & P!

1958-d **Montvale,NJ-Zaika, Al writes, "Ref.-Bergen County NJ telephone directory.

BE-19(652)17 - Beaver Falls Savings & Loan assn./1878-1955.....1954-d cent, rd. **Beaver Falls, PA-Aqua/Feisel/Zaika, H. Aqua writes, "This is from Beaver Falls, PA-as I said about BE-18(616)16-There are many varieties of encased from this institution." D. Feisel writes, "see attribution for BE-18(616)16. A. Zaika writes, "ref. I have a 1953 , Pa. firemens convention badge that was held in Beaver Falls, PA."

DE-5(657)17-DeNooyer Brothers Chevrolet, 1948-d, rd. **Battle Creek, MI, Lawniczak, Jim writes, "this piece is listed in the Michigan section of the Chevy series in Casement issue 7 on page 25. I think the article is describing two pieces with different placement of the words. I have seen this piece in several auctions and it is usually attributed to Battle Creek. I did an Internet search on DeNooyer Brothers Chevrolet and found nothing currently with that exact name. There is a DeNooyer Chevrolet in Albany, New York and also one in Kalamazoo, Michigan. Perhaps one brother moved east to New York and the other west to Kalamazoo?"

DI-5(658)17 - Burt Diebel/General Tires/Hollywood, 1958-d cent, rd. **Hollywood, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "listed in 1958 Dun & Bradstreet. I have two other pieces listed for this business. For this listing to be complete I need to know the location of the cent, the size, and the reverse. I would be interested in acquiring this piece for my collection and all the CA pieces attributed in issue 18."

DI-6(659)17 - Commemorating MacDill (A.F.B.)/Fed. Credit Union Dedication, 1969-d cent, rd. **MacDill Air Force Base, Florida -Tampa, FL, Feisel/Zaika-Al writes, "U.S. Postal Zip Code Directory."

DR-4(664)17 - Driscoll's Steak House/Jefferson at 10 mile Road....1952-d, hs. ** St Clair Shores, MI, Feisel/Lawniczak, Duane writes, "Street intersection fits", Jim L writes, " This address seemed familiar to me from the days when I lived in Michigan. Jefferson Avenue (I assumed your Jefferson was a typo) starts in downtown Detroit, follows the Detroit river west and then turns north when the river opens up into Lake St. Clair. The mile streets are east/west streets marking approximately how far north from downtown Detroit. therefore, I figured Ten Mile and Jefferson for St. Clair Shores. I called the St. Clair Shores Library and presto, the librarian actually remembered Driscoll's Steak House. She told me that the building was originally "Labidies Farm House,"then became the Driscoll's Steak House with a large Driscoll's on the roof. It eventually became Bobby Moore's Blind Fish Restaurant, which then burned down in 1997. The former location is now an empty field. So, I'll call Mav.(664) verified and add it with thanks to the Michigan catalog."

EN-1(668)17- 55000.00 given Away/By Enquirer/Guess....1986 cent, hs. **Cincinnati, Lawniczak/Stahurski, Jim writes, "Maverick no.(668) is an enigma to me. It is described as a 1986 horseshoe piece. It is clearly an Ohio piece as the word Ohio appears on it

with no city named. There is a piece that I have cataloged in the Ohio encased catalog with almost the exact same words as in your description. The only differences is that the amount at the beginning is "\$56,000.00 instead of 55,000.00." There are also differences in the line spacing from what is given in your description. The piece I know of is a wishbone and usually comes with a 1900 cent, although several used cents from the 1800s are known. I attributed this piece to Cincinnati, where the city newspaper is, and has been for quite some time, the "Enquirer," The Enquirer began publication in Cincinnati with the newspaper of April 10, 1841 and has published continuously since then. It looks to me like this piece promoted some kind of game for the 1900 election. The only way there would be a legitimate original 1986 horseshoe piece like the one described as EN-1(668) would be if some collector created one as a bit of a joke. My best guess is that the piece in question is a wishbone piece which had the cent punched out and someone put a 1986 cent in it. If the piece is really a horseshoe piece, I would like to see it." Terry S. writes, "I recall they had a newspaper that was named the Cincinnati Enquirer or something to that effect. This name is listed on the casement of this piece as well as "Ohio" so my guess might be valid."

FA-11(673)17 - Faney-Brockman/Clothes....1940 cent, hs. **Seattle, WA, Feisel/Zaika, Duane writes, "Street intersection right in downtown area. I would be interested in acquiring this piece for my collection. I have

begun a catalog of "good for" encased coins, and need information for the cent location and the size for a complete listing." Al writes, "ref.-1921 Dun Directory."

FI-8(676)17 - First Federal Savings & Loan-Wooster and Ashland.....1964 cent, rd.

****Wooster and Ashland, Ohio,** Feisel/Lawnizak/Stahurski, Jim writes, "This piece is listed in my Ohio catalog as (OH)-WOO/ASH -FI-10)Wooster and Ashland are two sister towns about 15 miles apart. I have actually not verified the piece to Ohio 100%, but three people have attributed the piece to Ohio and it is very likely it is an Ohio piece."

FI-9(677)17 - First Nat'l Bank & Trust-Floral Park, 1948 cent, rd.*Floral Park, NY or Santa Ana, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "First thought is Floral Park, NY, which may be correct. However, a listing of post offices shows a "Floral Park" branch in Santa Ana, CA. In 1953 D&B, there is a listing for a 1st National Bank. Further work needed."

FR-5(681)17 - The Franklin Savings Bank/Cor.42nd St. and 8th Ave.....1924 cent, rd.** New York, NY, Zaika, Al writes, "Polks Bank Directory"

GB-1(683)17 - G/B(on small shield) Finest Quality Beer, 1956-d cent, hs, **St. Louis, MO Zaika, Al writes, "G.B.Beer, Griesedieck Bros., St. Louis, MO. Ref. - American Brewery Directory, also a token that shows the complete name and logo."

GE-7(686)17 - Grey Eagle/Henry Gentrup, Prop./S.W.Cor. 6th & Elm.... 1901 cent, rd. **Cincinnati, OH, Feisel/Lawnizak, Duane writes,

"Several trade tokens and an encased cent listed in Ohio Merchant Tokens by Gaylor Lipscomb. I would be interested in acquiring this piece for my collection." Jim writes, "Listed in my Ohio as (OH)-(CIN)-GR-40. My source on this piece was not certain of the 1901 date, your information helps to solidify that. Although the piece is not self authenticating, Gaylor Lipscomb has listed two tokens (not encased) in his second edition of the Ohio Merchant Tokens book that absolutely identifies this encased piece. One token is for Grey Eagleat the same address and the other for Gentrup also at the address of this encased."

GE-8(687)17 - Germantown Savings Bank/Founded in 1854, 1973-d cent, rd. *Philadelphia, PA, Aqua/Zaika, Herman writes, "1973 Philadelphia Phone Book, page included. Al writes, "Germantown, IL-ref. Polks Bank Directory." Herman's clipping shows that the GSB in Philly was founded in 1854. Now if Al attribution proves the IL GSB was founded in 1854 then its a "push" otherwise Philly most likely is the home."

GL-3(690)17 - Souvenir of Glacier Park, 1957-d cent, hs. **Glacier Park, MT, Feisel

GL-4(691)17 - Glendale News-Press/Golden Anniversary1954-d cent, br, hs. **Glendale, CA, Feisel, Duane writes, "listed by Kappen".

GR-10(693)17 - Souvenir/ Great Smokey Mts., 1961-d cent, hs. **NC and TN, Feisel/ Lawnizak, Duane writes, "The Great Smoky Mountains National Park is located in both states." Jim writes, "This piece is in my collection and I don't think it can be attributed to a single state."

According to my att. both the Great Smoky Mountains and the Great Smoky Mountains National Park are in both North Carolina and Tennessee. So unless someone can pinpoint where the encased was actually given out, it is a two state piece."

Cost of Sending Encased Through the Mail by T. Hagens

A while back an ACE
member asked about postal
and insurance charges when
sending various numbers of
encased. I recently completed a
mail bid sale and sent a number
of encased. I kept track of the
mailing cost and decided to share
my findings with fellow Aces.

Keep in mind that this cost is
based on the weight of the
package which is determined of
course by what encased holder is
used, what size is included in
your package and the type of

mailer, plain envelope, padded
mailer or box. To keep it simple
each encased was housed
individually in a 2 1/2 x 2 1/2"
windowed cardboard holder with
three staples. The window
measures 42mm. Also included
were two rubber bands which
held both the encased coin(s) and
the one page invoice. The
mailers used were purchased
from the Quill Corp., 100 Shelter
Rd., Lincolnshire, IL, 60069-
3621 (800- '89-1339) and were
the 4x6" (000) bubble lined self-
adhesive envelope variety. The
cost was 16 cent each. (This is
one of the best buys I have
found. Does anyone know of
any better?) The encased holders
were purchased at a neighboring
coin shop, the cost here was
\$8.00 for 100. I have seen these
for sale from \$.05 to \$.10 each.
This size actually is too big for
the round encased but fits the
horseshoe perfectly and holds the
bell but is a bit small for this
type. Its too bad that some
company doesn't make a
cardboard holder for the
horseshoe encased. This has
been brought up by others in the
past. Or is there one out there?

The following is the postage
cost (first class) at the present
time. Less than 1 ounce- 33
cents plus 11 cents if the package
is thicker than the postal
standards. More than 1 ounce but
less than two ounces = 55 cents.
<2 ounces >3 ounces = 77 cents
<3 ounces >4 ounces = 99 cents
<4 ounces >5 ounces = \$1.21
<5 ounces >6 ounces = \$1.43
<6 ounces >7 ounces = \$1.65
<7 ounces >8 ounces = \$1.87
<8 ounces >9 ounces = \$2.09
<9 ounces >10 ounces = \$2.31

So with this in mind here is
the cost for sending encased,

remember the above mentioned
mailer, holders, staples and
rubber bands were all part of the
weight.

If you are sending more than 12
encased its time to increase the
size of the mailer. Be sure to
write on the package, "Please
Hand Stamp". And finally, add
the insurance cost if necessary
which is:

\$50.00 or less = \$.85

\$50.01 to \$100. = \$1.80

\$100.01 to \$5000.00 \$1.80

**plus \$.95 per \$100.00 of
insurance**

Hope the above chart can
help. I know before I was
sending "stuff" on a regular basis
I never paid much attention to
how the cost was figured. By the
way if your package is an exact
ounce you always pay the next
highest rate.

Replaced Indian Cents
by Jim Lawniczak

I have a very short additional comment on replaced Indian cents that might be of some interest to our members:

The more replaced Indian cents I have looked at, the more one thing strikes me -- the cent wears much differently in the encasement than it does in circulation. Here's where knowledge of coins can help in encased collecting. Take a look at an EF or AU circulated Indian cent (not an encased). The highest point on the obverse is on the ribbon with the four diamonds (right in the middle) and then on the hair extending down from the ribbon. An Indian cent in circulation begins to wear dramatically in this small area and substantial and very noticeable discoloration begins to occur in AU and certainly in EF circulated cents.

Now look at some of your Indian encased. The cents just don't wear the same way. This is because once the cent is in the encasement, the ribbon and the hair are no longer the high points subject to direct wear -- the encasement is protecting them. For example, I am now looking at a 1902 encased round clover Souvenir of Niagara Falls piece, which is certainly an original piece, as evidenced by the clover markings on the cent matching the clover design on the encased. The encasement has had substantial wear and is at best an EF piece, probably VF. The cent has also seen wear, but it is even wear across the entire piece, not centered on the ribbon and the hair. In fact, the ribbon and the diamonds have very little wear. I have never seen a regular AU or EF Indian cent that has worn this way.

This is just one other test to consider in determining whether a cent is original. It isn't an absolute rule, as it was possible that some lightly circulated Indian cents could have been used in some encasements. In fact, I just received a 1908 Indian encased which from other factors certainly has an original cent, but where there is substantial wear on the ribbon and the hair. My conclusion on this piece is that the piece was substantially circulated before it was put into the encasement. But if an uncirculated cent was used in the encasement, the wear pattern will differ on a cent that has been in an encasement its entire circulating life.

The more encased I look at, the more I believe that there are no absolute rules to determine whether a cent is original. The different shapes of encased with different thicknesses strike differently. I have seen encased where some light shows through (very small and not many examples) that I am convinced have original cents in them.

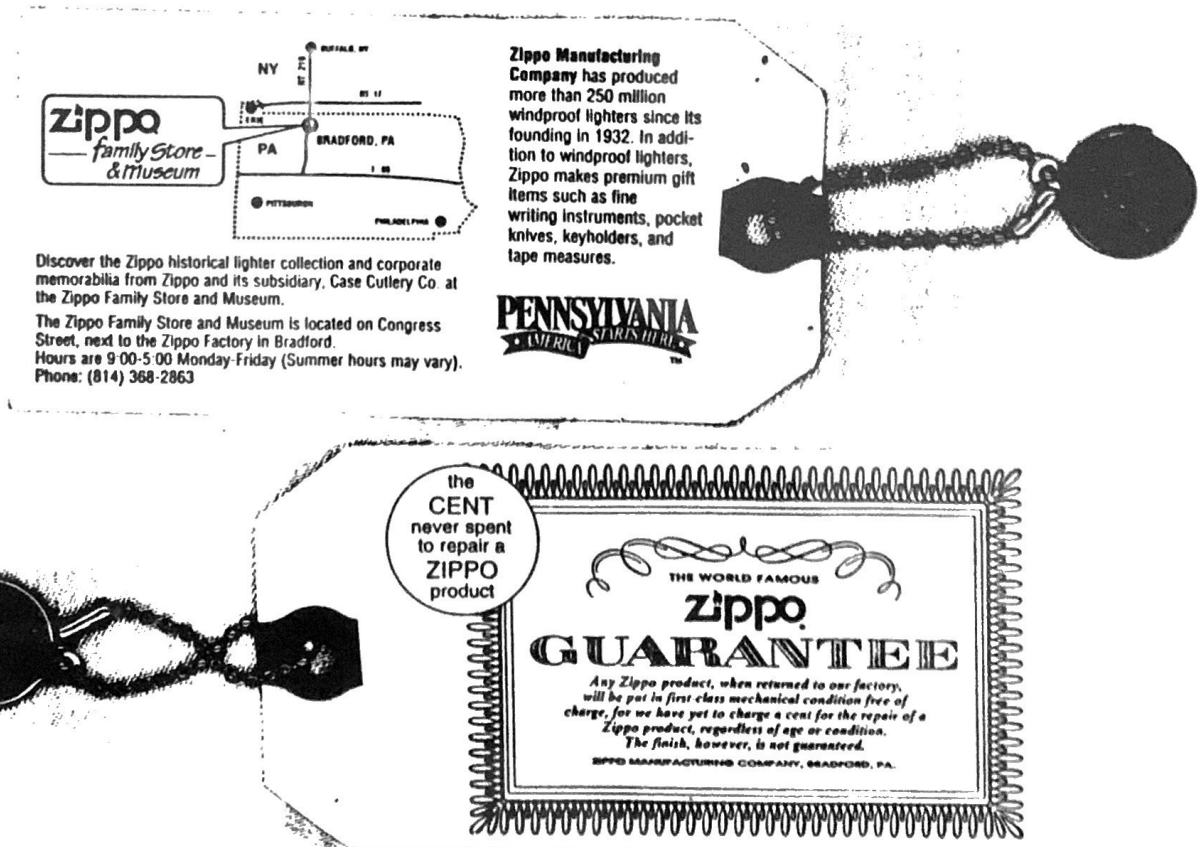
One thing that I have noticed is what can be done to light showing through by bending the encasement -- the aluminum. Aluminum is a pretty pliable material and can be bent fairly easily (the coin can only be bent with great pressure). I think you can bend an original encasement so that light shows through. I also think that you can bend a replaced cent in the right way so that no light shows through. It is because of the second fact that bent encasements where no light shows through are very suspect.

The Capped Zippo

American Bantam Car Co.

I don't own BA-10(412)12, a maverick encased cent issued by the American Bantam Car Co. that is listed on page 4 of Vol 4 No. 2 issue 12 (May, 1998) of "The Casement" but I do know a little about this company.

The American Austin Car Co. Inc. began operations in Butler, Pa. about 1930. This company made the "American Austin" series 2-75 roadster. This roadster was an attempt to popularize the European idea of an economy car, in this case the Austin Seven from Britain. List price was \$425.00. However, Americans preferred bigger cars and this company went into receivership in 1934.

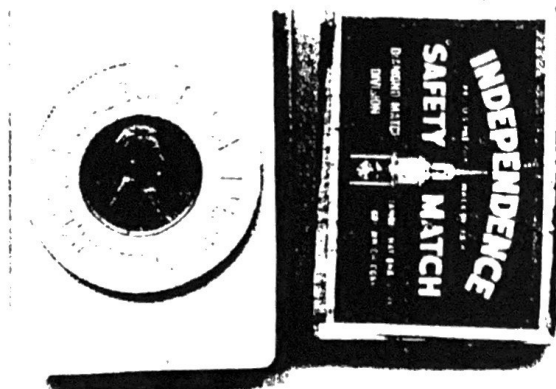
In 1935 The American Bantam Car Company took over on a more ambitious scale, with a large plant capable of turning out 44,000 vehicles a year. The plant was also located in Butler, Pa. But the "Bantam" was never more than a curiosity. Bantam designed and built the first successful "Jeep" for the U.S. Army in 1940. They were unable to deliver these in the quantity demanded, thus losing bulk orders to rival "Willys-Overland Co." of Toledo, Ohio. The American Bantam Car Co. discontinued operations in 1941.

Its interesting to note that this encased cent was "Good for 2 miles in a Bantam 60". Seems like the "60" (MPH) represented the top speed it would travel. Also note the sales pitch "America's only economy Car". Check out the "History Channel" on cable. They have a one hour program about the Bantan.

Here is the letter that is sent to all new members, as was mentioned in the editor's message. Even seasoned members are asked to read and of course hopefully contribute an article or paragraph to The Casement. Your ideas and collecting experiences are important.

Dear

Thanks for joining ACE. Your membership number is ACE # . Enclosed is your first issue of The Casement, issue 18. Your membership is good through the following issues, number 18, 19, 20 and 21. On your mailing label starting with this issue (18) and on all subsequent issues your ACE number and your expiration number (21) will follow your name. At the time when issue 21 comes out you will have to send another \$7.00 for renewal of membership then the 21 will change to 25 and the cycle starts again.

If you would like a free classified ad kindly send one or more up to 50 words. If you send one it will be in four issues unless you change it. The number which will be placed behind your classified ad is when the ad expires which also corresponds with the issue number.

If you enter any member mail bid auction you will receive a number which is just the order your bids were received. This changes with each mail bid and has nothing to do with the above numbers. I point this out because some members are confused about the numbers used in the different scenarios. The mail bid portion of the journal/newsletter is quite popular, it averages about 5 consignments an issue and about 25 to 30 bidders. There is a 5% charge to submit lots on consignment (5% of total sold). Minimum bids are permitted and consignment checks usually follow the closing date by about 30 days. As for bidding, any member can take part, you merely write the lot number down and the price your willing to pay. No advance payment is required. If you win any lots they are sent within 10 days of closing, postage and insurance is added. Minimum bid is \$1.50, bids are reduced if your bid is \$10.00 or more and the under bid allows for reducing. The rule is 10 percent over the under bid or half of your bid, which ever is larger.

Another popular area for ACE members is the maverick section. We hope you will identify any if you know the hometown and state. Also, you are welcome to send any for identification. Just send all the information on the encasement, along with the date and denomination, metal make-up and shape. Usually your maverick(s) will appear in one of the upcoming issues and hopefully someone will identify it.

Past issues of The Casement are available for \$1.00 each plus postage. Several issues are in low supply but presently all are available.

ACE is always looking for member news and information on encasements. Something of interest, how you got started, what you collect and why, your latest find or acquisition, information about a business that gave out encased coins for advertisement etc. Feel free to contribute to The Casement anytime on anything related to encased coins.

And finally ACE is producing 3 books (1/3 of the states in each) on all the known encased. As the lists are printed please contribute any corrections or additions. It will be most appreciated. Thanks again for joining and we hope you will get even more enjoyment out of the hobby of encased coin collecting now that you are an ACE member.
